The Middle Atlantic A.A.U. Wrestling Committee will not be conducting a Freestyle and Greco-Roman Program this year. We will have a Middle Atlantic A.A.U. Folkstyle Championship Tournament to be held on May 19th at Octorara High School, Atglen, PA. There will be competition in all age divisions from Bantam thru Masters.

The Middle Atlantic Championships is a qualifier for the Grand National A.A.U. Championships to be held on June 14 - 16 at Butte, Mt. There will be competition in Folkstyle, Freestyle and Greco-Roman.

For those in the Schoolboy, Cadet and Elite Divisions, A team will be selected from the Middle Atlantic Championships to represent this area in the National A.A.U. Junior Olympic Multi-Sport Championships to be held on July 29 - August 3 at Knoxville, TN. Again this year this will be a dual meet tournament with individual championships as well as a team champion. The Middle Atlantic Team has won this event for the past two years. There were 22 teams in the tournament last year. The Middle Atlantic Wrestling Association will transport the team to the competition.
