Time is almost upon us again to start thinking about the upcoming season of the Middle Atlantic Wrestling Association. Again the Middle Atlantic Wrestling Association is offering a comprehensive schedule of competition. We are beginning the 47th year of the Middle Atlantic Scholastic Wrestling Program in which 10,800 wrestlers competed last year. There are 34 District Tournaments held on six weekends at the following locations: March 1 at Cumberland Valley High School, Mechanicsburg, PA and Susquehannock High School, Glen Rock; March 8 Johnson City Middle School, Johnson City, NY and Watkins Glen High School, Watkins Glen, NY; March 9 North Allegheny Inter. School, Pittsburgh, PA; March 15 at Conestoga Valley High School, Lancaster, PA, Mifflinburg Inter. School, Mifflinburg, PA, North Schuylkill High School, Ashland, PA, Lake Lehman High School, Lehman, PA, Great Valley High School, Malvern, PA, A.I DuPont High School, Greenville, DE, Athens High School, Athens, PA, and Annapolis Area Christian School, Severn, MD; High Point High School, Sussex, NJ; March 15 & 16 River Hill High School, Clarksville, MD and Eastern Ct. State University, Willimantic, CT; March 16 at Lock Haven University, Lock Haven, PA; March 22 Washington Township High School, Sewell, NJ, Hughesville High School, Hughesville, PA, Chestnut Ridge High School, New Paris, PA, Waynesboro High School, Waynesboro, PA, Juniata High School, Mifflintown, PA; Pennsville High School, Pennsville, NJ and Nansemond River High School, Suffolk, VA; March 22 & 23 Fauquier County High School, Warrenton, VA, March 23 Tunkhannock High School, Tunkhannock, PA and St. Johns College High School, Washington, DC; March 29 Middletown High School, Middletown, NY, Upper Merion High School, King of Prussia, PA and Toms River East High School, Toms River, NJ; March 30 Northern Burlington Regional High Sch, Columbus, NJ, Souderton High Sch, Souderton, PA and Londonderry High Sch, Londonderry, NH and April 5 Northampton High Sch, Northampton, PA. From these district tournaments, the top three will qualify for the Middle Atlantic Wrestling Association Regional tournaments.

This year Regional Tournaments will be held on **March 29 & 30 Shippensburg University, Shippensburg, PA, April 5 & 6 at Shamokin High School, Coal Township, PA, April 12 & 13 at Liberty High School, Bethlehem, PA and Wicomico Civic Center, Salisbury, MD.** From these Regional Tournaments, the top four will advance to the Middle Atlantic Wrestling Association's Eastern National Wrestling Championships to be held on **May 3-4 at the Wicomico Civic Center, Salisbury, MD.** There is an additional \$10.00 entry fee required for the Regionals and Finals. Again this year there will be a match at the Regional Tournaments to determine 5th and 6th places and will be alternates for the Eastern Nationals.
